

Photographic and Social Media Policy

- Members or Volunteers must not take photos of participants/children and young people on personal devices including phones and cameras.
- In accordance with our Safeguarding Procedures, no photography is permitted in dressing rooms.
- The Carver Theatre on occasion employs photographers and there
 are times when members will use theatre camera equipment;
 images/footage will only be captured of children who have
 provided consent.
- Volunteers and members must not use images of children and young people participating in Carver activities, for personal use or promotion i.e. on social media.
- Volunteers must not interact with children or young people outside of the Carver Theatre activities, including via social media. This includes being "followed by" or "friends with" children and young people on social media platforms.
- Audience members and parents/carers attending performances of children's work are only permitted to take photographs or videos of performances if permissions are obtained for all children participating, and parents are asked not to share these via any social media platform.
- The Carver Theatre social media channels are managed by our Marketing Officer who will operate in-line with our social media policy.
