Learning & Audition Prep Sessions:

Auditions: 3rd March **Callbacks:** 10th March

These sessions will prepare young people for our **Summer Show: *SpongeBob SquarePants: The Musical***. Participants in the Carver programme will also receive **priority for pantomime auditions**.

Rehearsal schedule will be circulated prior to auditions. ***We anticipate having a place in show for every workshop attendee***

Group Structure

- **Juniors:** Years 3–6
- **Youth:** Years 7–13

Fees

- **£5 per week paid monthly**
- **£15 per month (February–July)** – includes workshops, rehearsals, the show, and the end-of-season party
- **£10 per month for siblings**

Weekly Timings

- **Juniors:** 6:00pm – 7:00pm
- **Youth:** 7:00pm – 9:00pm *Additional flexibility will be built in during show rehearsal periods.*

What to Wear

Young people should wear:

- Black clothing suitable for movement
- Black shoes (jazz shoes, pumps, or dance trainers)

A **Carver workshop t-shirt** will be available, and a **sustainable hoodie** will be produced with removable show badges to avoid fast fashion waste.

Adult Requirements & Parental Engagement

- All adults involved will undergo **DBS checks**.
- All adults will be **members of Carver Theatre**.
- At least one parent should join as a Carver member and volunteer during at least one Carver production a year as well as supporting the Summer Show.

Administration & Communication

- A **Junior Registrar** will manage weekly sign-in/out and act as the main point of contact.
- A **new combined Facebook page** will be launched for updates and communication.
- Young people will help choose the **new group name**, ensuring the programme reflects their identity and creativity.
